

# Webelos Night Hike Route

*The hike is a fairly flat, paved trail known as the Canal Trail. The route is 3 miles round-trip with an elevation change of about 100 feet. Along the way, you will see from a distance both the canal and Jordan River, train tracks where Frontrunner passes by, the gravel pit, and possibly paragliders. As you reach the halfway mark, you will pass by a small farm just after a bridge. On your left you will see a small hill on the farm; when you reach this point, you may turn around.*

Please take note of the following:

- Use the restrooms in the LDS Church located north of the park. There are NO restrooms along the way.
- Check in at the southwest corner of the park.
- You will be directed to the trail. As you go, watch for trail markings to indicate the correct route.
- A small section of the trail at the beginning has a steep side on the east that goes down about 10 feet. Please be aware of your Webelos at all time.
- Be sure to bring water and your snack; there are no drinking fountains along the path. We will have water available at the beginning and end of the hike.
- Upon completion of the hike, Webelos will receive a pin to place over the compass image on their patch. Leaders may purchase a pin for \$1.
